ORDER AUTHORIZING SAN JACINTO DAY FIREWORKS SALES

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Robertson County is authorized under Occupations Code Section 2154.202 (h), to issue an order allowing retail fireworks permit holders to sell fireworks to the public in celebration of San Jacinto Day; and

WHEREAS, on the 19th day of March 2024, the Commissioners Court of Robertson County has determined that conditions are favorable to issue such an Order;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commissioners' Court of Robertson County adopts this Order authorizing the sale of fireworks to the public by retail fireworks permit holders during the San Jacinto Day period beginning April 16, 2024 and ending at midnight April 21, 2024, subject to the following restrictions:

- a) No person may sell, detonate, ignite, or in any way use fireworks classified under 49 C.F.R. part. 173.100(r)(2) (10-1-86 edition), as "skyrockets with sticks" and "missiles with fins" in the specified areas of Robertson County.
- b) This order expires on the date the Texas Fire Service determines drought conditions exist in the county or midnight, April 21, 2024, whichever is earlier.
