2. BUDGET WORKSHOP

A. Discuss and take action to consider making changes to the proposed fiscal year 2023-24 budget that the Commissioners Court considers warranted by the law and required by the interest of the taxpayers. Motion was made by Commissioner Taylor to approve the Tax Office repairs to the back wall (not to exceed \$45,00.00) to be paid out of overall reserves, seconded by Commissioner Hairston and motion carried unanimously.
