Total maximum annual production from the water well will be 420 ac-ft/yr at a maximum rate of 300 gpm for Agricultural, Commercial, and Industrial uses. The well produces from the Calvert Bluff Aquifer. Permittee seeks amendments to the permit adding Industrial and Commercial beneficial uses and increasing total maximum annual production from 110 ac-ft/year to 420 ac-ft/year at a maximum rate not to exceed 300 gpm.
