

ORDER AUTHORIZING CINCO DE MAYO FIREWORKS SALES

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Robertson County is authorized under Occupations Code Section 2154.202(g)(3), to issue an order allowing retail fireworks permit holders to sell fireworks to the public in celebration of Cinco de Mayo; and

WHEREAS, on the 6th day of April 2021, the Commissioners Court of Robertson County has determined that conditions are favorable to issue such an Order;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commissioners' Court of Robertson County adopts this Order authorizing the sale of fireworks to the public by retail fireworks permit holders during the Cinco de Mayo period beginning May 1, 2021 and ending at midnight May 5, 2021, subject to the following restrictions:

- a) No person may sell, detonate, ignite, or in any way use fireworks classified under 49 C.F.R. part. 173.100(r)(2) (10-1-86 edition), as "skyrockets with sticks" and "missiles with fins" in the specified areas of Robertson County.
- b) This order expires on the date the Texas Fire Service determines drought conditions exist in the county or midnight, May 5, 2021, whichever is earlier.
