DISASTER DECLARATION RELATED TO SEVERE WEATHER

WHEREAS, Robertson County, since the 23th day of April, 2025, has suffered widespread damage and loss of county property resulting from severe storms, flooding, and wind that occurred in Robertson County and surround area; and

WHEREAS, the County of Robertson has severe damage, possibly personal injury and loss of property resulting in ongoing severe weather, flooding and wind; and


WHEREAS, the judge of County of Robertson as determined that extraordinary measures must be taken for the safety of the people of Robertson County and to preserve and project the property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE JUDGE OF THE COUNTY OF ROBERTSON

1. That a state of disaster is declared for the county of Robertson pursuant to 418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.
2. That Robertson County's Emergency Management Plan has been implemented.
3. That this state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven (7) day after its issuance, unless the commissioners court consents to its renewal.
4. It is estimated that severe weather storm damage will exceed

BE IT THEREFORE PROCLAIMED that I, Joe David Scarpinato, County Judge of Robertson County, declare a local state of disaster based on the threat of drought conditions in Robertson County, Texas.
