

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Robertson County Commissioners Court will conduct a public hearing at its March 31, 2026 meeting to consider and to act upon a Resolution to enter into a Tax Abatement Agreement with Buffalo Meadow Energy Center, LLC pursuant to the provisions of the Property Redevelopment and Tax Abatement Act, Chapter 312 of the Texas Tax Code.

The property subject to the Agreement is a 200 MW solar power generation facility with consisting of underground collection systems, transmission lines, electrical interconnections, roads, control systems necessary for commercial generation of electricity, solar modules/panels, racking and mounting structures, inverters boxes, combiner boxes, meteorological equipment, maintenance and operations building, paving, fencing, electrical substations, generation transmission tie line and associated towers, and interconnection facilities and would be located in the Buffalo Meadow Energy Center Reinvestment Zone created by the Robertson County Commissioner's Court on March 3, 2026. The Reinvestment Zone is a 2,100+/- tract lying in northeastern Robertson County approximately 5.3 miles north of Franklin. Anticipated cost to construct the facility is approximately \$200 million.

The meeting will take place at 2:00 p.m. on Tuesday, March 31, at 102 East Decherd, Franklin, TX 77856.
