EXTENSION OF LOCAL DISASTER FOR PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, beginning in December, 2019, a novel coronavirus, now designated COVID-19 was detected in mainland China, and has since spread throughout the world; and

WHEREAS, the World Health Organization declared COVID-19 a worldwide pandemic on March 11, 2020; and

WHEREAS, extraordinary measures must be taken to contain COVID-19 and prevent its spread throughout Robertson County; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COMMISSIONER'S COURT OF ROBERTSON COUNTY, TEXAS:

- 1. That a state of disaster was declared for Robertson County, Texas pursuant to section 418 of the Texas Government Code on March 17, 2020.
- 2. That the County's Emergency Management Plan has been implemented.
- 3. That this state of disaster shall be extended for a period of 30 days of the date hereof, unless the same is continued by consent of the Commissioners Court of the County of Robertson, Texas.
- 4. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
