
- A. Discuss and take action on approving budget adjustments and/or amendments, credit applications and/or lease purchase agreements, and/or cell phone allowance agreements.

Motion was made by Commissioner Rampy to approve the budget adjustments as presented (see attached adjustments), seconded by Commissioner Hairston and motion carried unanimously.
Motion was made by Commissioner Threadgill to approve voiding check number 163481 and reissuing a new one for the same amount for the grapple truck that was previously approved, seconded by Judge Scarpinato and motion carried unanimously.





