


- A. The Robertson County Commissioners' Court will reconvene in a public meeting to discuss and take action on related matters.




Motion was made by Commissioner Threadgill to adjourn, seconded by Commissioner Rampy and motion carried unanimously.




Robertson County Judge




Commissioner Precinct #1
