

NOTICE OF MEETING TO VOTE ON TAX RATE

A tax rate of \$0.07730 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of Robertson County Emergency Services District.

PROPOSED TAX RATE	\$0.07730 per \$100
NO-NEW-REVENUE TAX RATE	\$0.07816 per \$100
VOTER-APPROVAL TAX RATE	\$0.08042 per \$100

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2021 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for Robertson County Emergency Services District from the same properties in both the 2020 tax year and the 2021 tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that Robertson County Emergency Services District may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that Robertson County Emergency Services District is not proposing to increase property taxes for the 2021 tax year.

A PUBLIC MEETING TO VOTE ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON September 14, 2021 AT 6:30 PM AT Robertson County EMS Conference Room.

The proposed tax rate is also not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, Robertson County Emergency Services District is not required to hold an election at which voters may accept or reject the proposed tax rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the of Robertson County Emergency Services District at their offices or by attending the public meeting mentioned above.

YOUR TAXES OWED UNDER ANY OF THE RATES MENTIONED ABOVE CAN BE CALCULATED AS FOLLOWS:

$$\text{Property tax amount} = (\text{tax rate}) \times (\text{taxable value of your property}) / 100$$

The 86th Texas Legislature modified the manner in which the voter-approval tax rate is calculated to limit the rate of growth of property taxes in the state.

The following table compares the taxes imposed on the average residence homestead by Robertson County Emergency Services District last year to the taxes proposed to be imposed on the average residence homestead by Robertson County Emergency Services District this year.
