

he Beard of Directors may meet in closed session, pursuant to the Texas Open Meeting Act, Texas Government Code § 551.071-551.076 to:

- 1. Consult with an attorney to seek advice about pending or contemplated litigation or a settlement offer;(551.071)
- 2. deliberate regarding the purchase, exchange, lease, or value of real property if deliberation in an open meeting would have a detrimental effect on the position of the Corporation in negotiation with a third person; (551.072)
- deliberate a negotiated contact for a prospective gift or donation to the Corporation if deliberation in an open meeting would have a detrimental effect on the
 position of the Corporation in negotiations with a third person; (551.073)
- 4. to deliberate the appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline, or dismissal of a Board member or Corporation employee; (551.074)
- 5. to receive information from employees or question employees, but no deliberate public business or agency policy that affects public business (551.075)
- to deliberate the employment or specific occasions for implementation of security personnel or devices and (551.076) executive session could result in action in open session.
- 7. the Board may also meet in open session on these matters required by the Texas Open Meeting Act, Texas Government Code (§551.102)
