LEGAL NOTICE

The Brazos Valley Groundwater Conservation District (District), in compliance with Chapter 36 of the Texas Water Code and its Rules, will receive public comments on proposed amendments to the Rules of the District or District policies during a Public Rules Hearing at 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, September 11, 2025, at the Brazos Valley Groundwater Conservation District Office in Hearne, Texas (112 W. 3rd Street). The proposed amendments include but are not limited to District Rules associated with statutes enacted during the 89th Texas Legislative Session and a new Rule 7.1(f) related to minimum tract size and production rate requirements for wells located within a platted subdivision.

The District Board, at the conclusion of the public hearing, will discuss comments received and consider possible adoption of the proposed rules or policies. Written and oral public comments on the proposed rules or policies must be submitted to the District on or prior to the hearing date.
