

- **The purchaser will have to show:**

a statement from the county assessor-collector in the county where the sale takes place showing that the purchaser does not owe delinquent ad-valorem taxes, including those due to a school district; or a written statement from the county assessor-collector stating that the person is a registered bidder at the sale being conducted.

- **No bidders may bid or purchase property in the name of another person; and**

- **The deed executed by the officer after sale must name the winning bidder from the sale as the grantee and state that the tax statement was in order.**
