The Board of Directors may meet in closed session, pursuant to the Texas Open Meeting Act, Texas Government Code sections 551.071-551.076, to:

1. consult with an attorney to seek his or her advice on legal matters about pending or contemplated litigation, a settlement offer, or on a matter in which the duty of the attorney to the Corporation under the Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct of the State Bar of Texas clearly conflicts with Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code (sec. 551.071);
2. deliberate regarding the purchase, exchange, lease, or value of real property if deliberation in an open meeting would have a detrimental effect on the position of the Corporation in negotiation with a third person (sec. 551.072);
3. deliberate a negotiated contract for a prospective gift or donation to the Corporation if deliberation in an open meeting would have a detrimental effect on the position of the Corporation in negotiations with a third person (sec. 551.073);
4. deliberate the appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline, or dismissal of a Board member or Corporation employee (sec. 551.074);
5. receive information from employees or question employees, but no deliberate public business or agency policy that affects public business (sec. 551.075); or
6. deliberate the employment or specific occasions for implementation of security personnel or devices and executive session could result in action in open session (sec. 551.076).

The Board may also meet in open session on these matters required by the Texas Open Meeting Act, Texas Government Code (551.102).
