 - **One (1) Operating permit for Pinnacle Gas Treatment LLC:**

Well #2 (**BVDO-0426**): Located at: N 31.22628003° W 96.758640° 2.21 miles SSW of the intersection of Cole Branch Road and SH-7 in Robertson County. Total maximum annual production from the water well is 96.78 ac-ft/yr at a maximum rate of 60 gpm for Industrial use. The well produces from the Calvert Bluff Aquifer. Permit holder seeks an amendment lengthening the permit term from one (1) year to five (5) years.
 - **One (1) Operating permit for Travis Materials, LLC:**


Well #7 (**BVOP-0323**): Located at: N 30.78545294° W 96.758640° 2.54 miles W of the intersection of FM 50 and Woodswitch Gin Road in Robertson County. Total maximum annual production from the water well is 60 ac-ft/yr at a maximum rate of 500 gpm for Industrial use. The well produces from the Brazos River Alluvium Aquifer. Permit holder seeks an amendment to increase the total maximum annual production from the well to 400 ac-ft/year.

- (4) to deliberate the appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline or dismissal of a Board member or District employee;
- (5) to receive information from employees or question employees, but not deliberate public business or agency policy that affects public business; and
- (6) to deliberate the deployment or specific occasions for implementation of security personnel or devices.
